The goal was to provide a historical focal point in Downtown Crossville and a low cost meeting room for groups and individuals of Cumberland County. What was once the baggage and storage building is now a meeting room for showers,

receptions, business meetings or other functions with a fully equipped kitchen (stove, refrigerator, microwave, etc.) You may make reservations for 2 hours for \$30 or the entire day for \$75 by calling 931-858-5232. The gift shop is open Monday through Saturday 9am to 6 pm. The Crossville Depot Gift Shop and the newly painted caboose attract many residents and visitors to our downtown.
